

Create a Board Game About Plants

What You Need

- Scissors
- 2 number cubes
- · Coloring materials

- Glue
- Construction paper
- A base for the game board, such as poster board, a clean pizza box, or a file folder



What You Do

- 1. On the board game base, draw a path that the game pieces will follow. Some path ideas are: a U shape, an L shape, a square, or an oval. Make your path at least 50 squares long.
- **2.** Add spaces where you have to stack question cards. Print instructions on some game board spaces.
- 3. Make question cards by printing or writing questions on heavy paper.
- 4. Test the game to see if it is too difficult or has enough spaces.
- **5.** Cut small figures out of paper to use as game pieces, or use materials that are available such as bottle tops, candy, or small toys.
- **6.** Decorate the game board to make it colorful so people know it is about plants.
- 7. Write the rules and directions on how to play the game.

Rules and How to Play

- How does a player move around the board? Here are some ideas:
 - roll the number cubes
 - pick up a card and answer a question
 - follow the instructions on the game board spaces
- Are there penalties for wrong answers?
- · How many players can play?

Ideas for Game Cards

Create questions about plants to test players' knowledge. Create different categories such as:

- true or false
- explain
- · multiple choice

Ideas for Game Board Spaces

- miss a turn
- go back 5 spaces
- roll the number cubes again
