Be	Do	Have
<i>I am</i>	<i>I do</i>	<i>I have</i>
<i>he is, she is, it is</i>	<i>he does, she does, it does</i>	<i>he has, she has, it has</i>
<i>we are, you are, they are</i>	<i>we do, you do, they do</i>	<i>we have, you have, they have</i>
