On the Outside

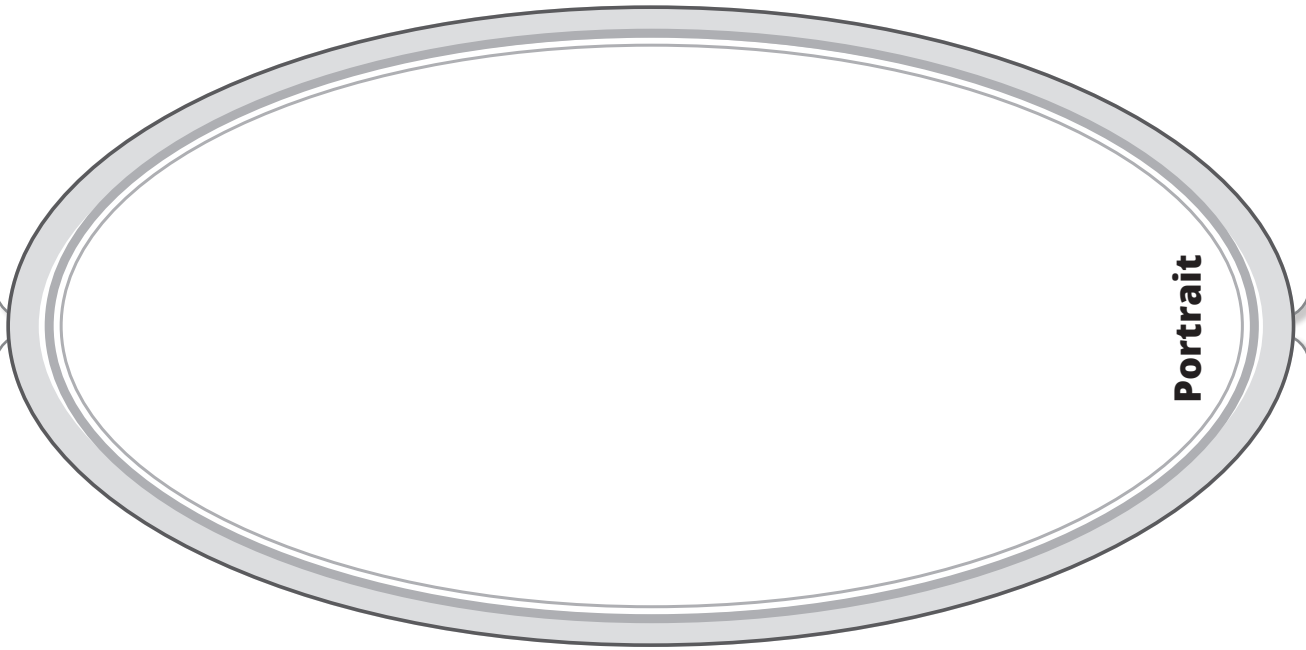
(Physical Traits)
